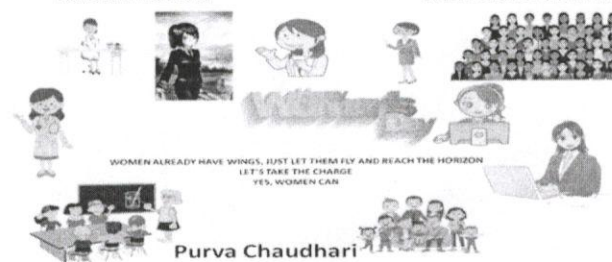
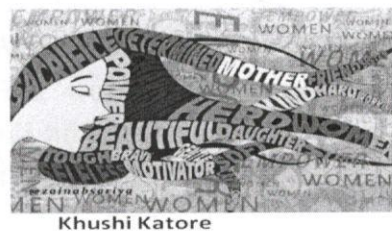
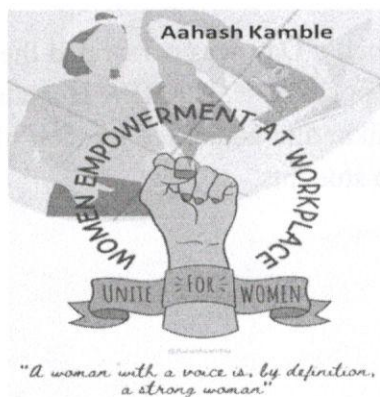
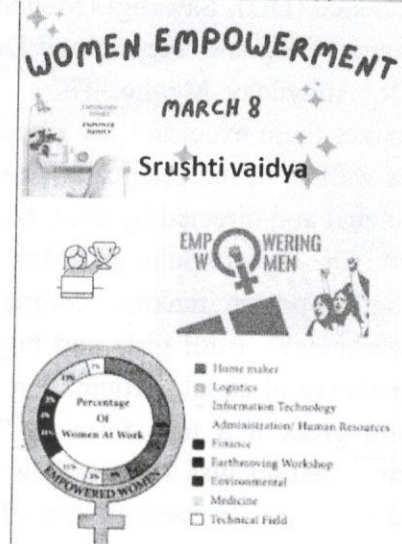
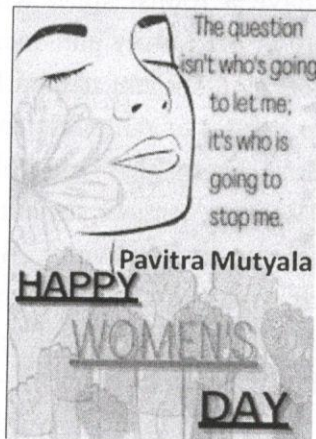
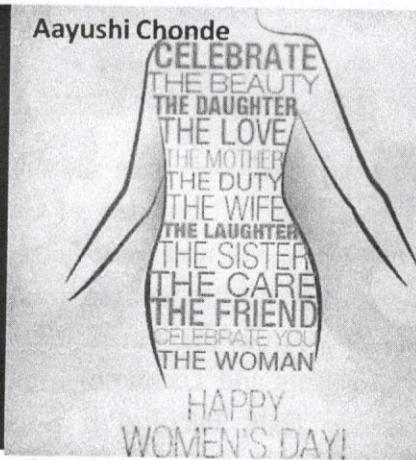
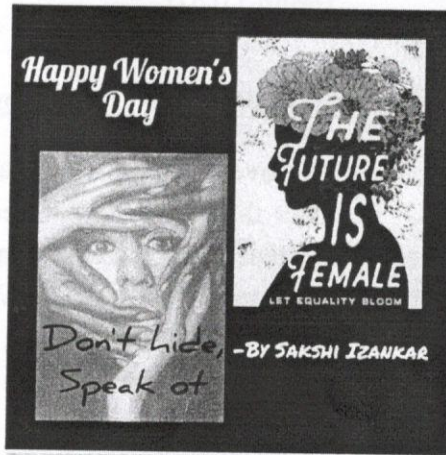
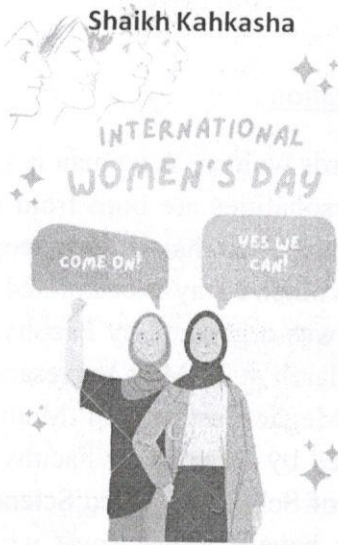




Report on International Women's Day celebration

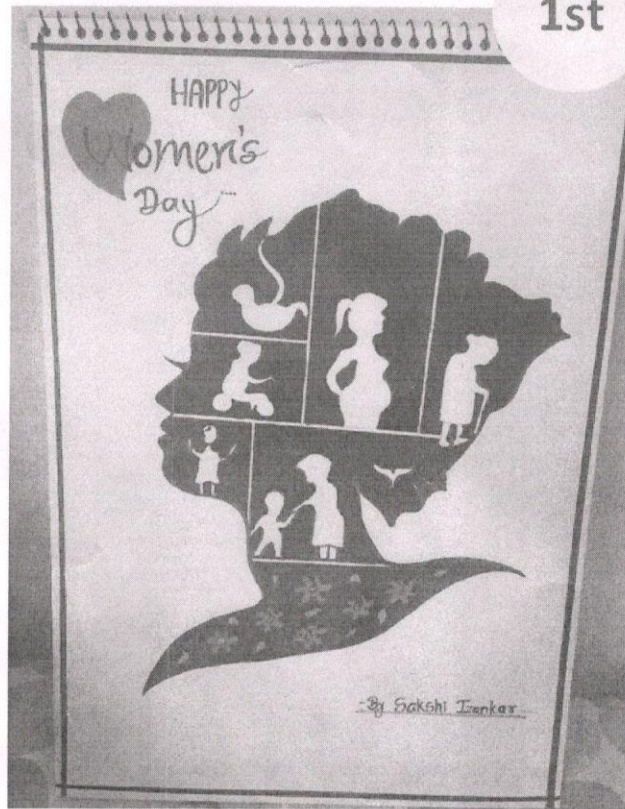
