## CONTRAINDICATIONS:

- Tissue from donors with the following is potentially hazardous to eye bank personnel and harvesting eyes should be strictly avoided.
  - Active Viral Hepatitis
  - Acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS) of HIV
  - Active viral encephalitis or encephalitis of unknown origin
  - Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease
  - Suspected rabies and persons who, within the past six months, were bitten by an animal suspected to be infected with rabies.
- Conditions with potential risk of transmission of local or systemic communicable disease from donor to recipient.
- Conditions with potential risk of transmission of non communicable disease from donor to recipient.
- Conditions that will affect graft outcome.



## TRAUMA:

- Cause for Unilateral loss of vision.
- Up to 5% of all bilateral blindness has been attributed to direct ocular trauma.
- Variable amount of blindness.
- Penetrating injuries result in acquired corneal scarring in the pediatric age group.
- The most common injury was bow and arrow (15.2%), followed by household appliances (14.3%).
- Most ocular injuries in children from unsupervised activities.





## CORNEAL BLINDNESS

- This is the third leading cause of blindness .
- In India, 6.8 million people have a vision less than 6/60 in at least one eye; of these, about a million have bilateral involvement.
- Approximately 20,000 patients are added to the backlog each year and out of that 50% of corneal blindness is treatable.
- Corneal blind patients-----corneal transplantation.
- An efficient and precise utilization of the donor corneas in developing countries like India is only possible after a complete knowledge of the collection, storage and utilization of donor tissues.

## Causes of Blindness:

- Uncorrected refractive error such as Myopia, Hyperopia or Astigmatism
- Cataracts
- Age-related macular degeneration
- Glaucoma
- Diabetic retinopathy

The number of blind is expected to triple within the next four decades, cases going from 36 million to 115 million by 2050. Increasing life expectancy in the global population; poor access to healthcare in some low income countries, the number of blind and visually impaired people continues to **increase**.

- Eye Retrieval Centre (ERC): Affiliated to registered eye bank.
- Eye Bank (EB): Round the clock public response system regarding eye donation. Harvest, process, preserve, evaluate, distribute and safe transport of donor cornea.
