
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
INFECTIOUS KERATITIS:

- Approximately 1.5-2 million people develop corneal ulcer annually in our country.










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- This is the third leading cause of blindness.
- In India, 6.8 million people have a vision less than 6/60 in at least one eye; of these, about a million have bilateral involvement.
- Approximately 20,000 patients are added to the backlog each year and out of that 50% of corneal blindness is treatable.
- Corneal blind patients----corneal transplantation.
- An efficient and precise utilization of the donor corneas in developing countries like India is only possible after a complete knowledge of the collection, storage and utilization of donor tissues.

The number of blind is expected to triple within the next four decades, cases going from 36 million to 115 million by 2050. Increasing life expectancy in the global population; poor access to healthcare in some low income countries, the number of blind and visually impaired people continues to **increase**.
