ORDER

Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed to be University), Sawangi (Meghe), Wardha, Maharashtra vide its letter No.DMIMS/DU/2022-23/84 dated 25th April, 2022 had applied for recognition against increased intake of 4 seats (14 to 18) of MD (General Medicine) qualification in respect of students being trained at Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College, Sawangi (Meghe), Wardha, having an annual intake capacity of twenty-four seats in the said course.

2. WHEREAS the Post-Graduate Medical Education Board (PGMEB) got the assessment of Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College, Sawangi (Meghe), Wardha done on 23rd February, 2023 for verification of infrastructure, clinical material, faculty for all-round training of students as per curriculum requirement. On scrutiny of the Assessment Report and other records, the Post-Graduate Medical Education Board (PGMEB) found the following deficiencies:

- i. Deficiency of three Assistant Professors and one Senior Resident; and
- ii. Inadequate bed occupancy considering the twenty-four PG students studying in the medical college.

3. WHEREAS, the deficiencies stated in **para 2 above** were pointed out to the said medical college vide PGMEB Letter No.35/502(30)/2022-PGMEB/018988 dated 13th April, 2023 and the medical college was given an opportunity to submit a written explanation in respect of the deficiencies. The said medical college furnished the reply vide letter No.JNMC/2023-24/178 dated 11th May, 2023. The Compliance Verification Report, furnished by the said medical college, was placed before the Post-Graduate Medical Education Board. The reply furnished by the medical college was not found satisfactory and acceptable by the Board because the medical college, in its reply, has failed to justify how the IPD clinical workload (just 60%) in the Department is sufficient for annual intake of twenty-four post-graduate seats for (seventy-two postgraduate students studying at a given time). Further, the report of the Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System (AEBAS) shows that there is deficiency of three Assistant Professors and three Senior Residents in the Department.

4. WHEREAS, the responsibility of determination and maintenance of standards of post-graduate medical education is entrusted upon the Post-Graduate Medical Education Board of the National Medical Commission as per National Medical Commission Act, 2019 (NMC Act, 2019), Post-Graduate Medical Education Regulations-2000 (PGMER-2000) and Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023 (MSMER-2023). As per **A.1.15 of Schedule-I** of the Minimum Requirements for Annual M.B.B.S. Admissions Regulations, 2020, installation of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System (AEBAS) is mandatory and NMC has been advising the medical colleges/institutes to install the Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System (AEBAS) from time to time. With a view to

effectively implement the AEBAS, NMC vide its letter No.D.130024/07/2022/NMC/DMMP dated 1st August, 2022 issued instructions to all medical colleges/institutions to install AEBAS devices for biometric attendance. Further, Section 6.2 of the PGMER-2000 and Section 8(1) and (2) of the MSMER-2023 stipulate imposition of penalty(ies) on the medical college/institution, if they fail to comply with any statutory provisions.

5 WHEREAS the medical college has failed to comply with the requirements and has compromised with the quality of medical education. Considering the inadequate clinical workload in the Department of General Medicine, which is just adequate for twenty-one seats, the Post-Graduate Medical Education Board has decided to approve twenty-one seats and to reduce the annual intake capacity in the course of MD (General Medicine) from the existing twenty-four to twenty-one seats from the Academic Year 2024-2025. Hence, the break-up of the MD (General Medicine) seats in the medical college will be as indicated below:

* - The medical college will apply for recognition of the Permitted Seats (18 to 21) in 2025.

However, the students admitted by the medical college till the Academic Year 2023-2024 will not be affected by this reduction of seats and their post-graduate degrees will be considered recognised for the purpose of registration of the degree awarded by the University.

6. The recognition so being granted herein, shall be valid for a maximum period of five (5) years from the date of issue, upon which it shall have to be renewed. The procedure for 'Renewal of Recognition' shall be same as applicable for the award of Recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to be concerned post-graduate course.

7. WHEREAS, the medical college is free to prefer an appeal before the National Medical Commission under Section 35(5) of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019 and Section 9 of Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023, within sixty days from the date of issuance of this letter in accordance with NMC letter No.C.16013/36/2022/NMC/Coord dated 28.12.2022 and 28.08.2023, if they so desire, at the email id nmc_appeal@nmc.org.in.
