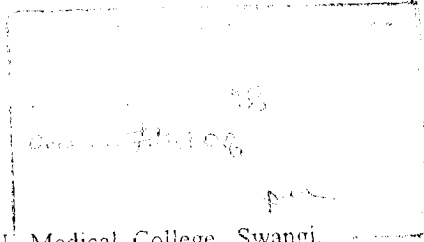



Medical College, Swangi for purpose of approval of the college for the award of DO qualification granted by Nagpur University and the Council approved the following recommendations of Postgraduate Committee:-

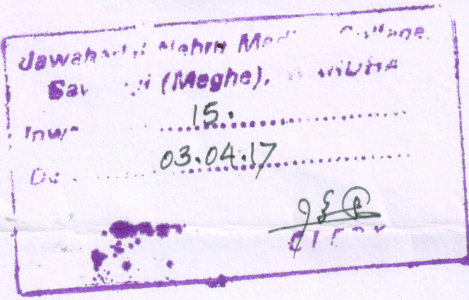


