ORDER

The **Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College, Sawangi (Meghe), Wardha**, affiliated to the Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed to be University), Sawangi (Meghe), Wardha, Maharashtra *vide* its Letter No.JNMC/2022-23/36 dated 25th April, 2022 had applied for **renewal of recognition of two seats (10 to 12) and recognition against increased intake of four seats (12 to 16) of MS (General Surgery)** qualification in respect of students being trained at the medical college, having an annual intake capacity of **twenty-four seats** in the said course.

2. WHEREAS, the Post-Graduate Medical Education Board (PGMEB) got the assessment of the **Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College, Sawangi (Meghe), Wardha** done on **23th February, 2023** for verification of infrastructure, clinical material, faculty for all-round training of students as per curriculum requirement. On scrutiny of the Assessment Report and other records, the Post-Graduate Medical Education Board (PGMEB) found the following deficiencies:

- i. Deficiency of thirteen Assistant Professors; and
- ii. Inadequate Surgical workload in the Department.

3. WHEREAS, the deficiencies stated in **para 2 above** were pointed out to the said medical college *vide* PGMEB Letter No.35/502(28)/2022-PGMEB/018993 dated 13th April, 2023 and the medical college was given an opportunity to submit a written explanation in respect of the deficiencies. The said medical college furnished the reply *vide* Letter No.JNMC/2023-24/180 dated 11th May, 2023. The Compliance Verification Report, furnished by the said medical college, was placed before the Post-Graduate Medical Education Board. The Board observed that on the day of inspection, the bed occupancy and the surgical load in the **Department of General Surgery** was inadequate. Further, the average of bed occupancy on the random three days was also inadequate.

4. Subsequently, the medical college was given an opportunity to explain the deficiency during the personal hearing conducted through videoconference on 26.10.2023. During the Personal Hearing, the medical college put forth their views on the low surgical workload in the Department. However, the Board explained to the medical college that the surgical workload in the Department is inadequate in terms of the NMC norms for the annual intake of twenty-four seats. Hence, the Board has concluded that the bed occupancy and the surgical load in the Department of General Surgery is inadequate to train the PG students studying in the medical college.

5. WHEREAS, the responsibility of determination and maintenance of standards of post-graduate medical education is entrusted upon the Post-Graduate Medical


Education Board of the National Medical Commission as per National Medical Commission Act, 2019 (NMC Act, 2019), Post-Graduate Medical Education Regulations-2023 (PGMER-2023) and Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023 (MSMER-2023). Further, **Section 8(1) and (2)** of the MSMER-2023, stipulate imposition of penalty(ies) on the medical college/institution, if they fail to comply with any statutory provisions.

6. WHEREAS the medical college has failed to comply with the requirements and has compromised with the quality of medical education. **Considering the low bed occupancy and low surgical workload in the Department of General Surgery, the Post-Graduate Medical Education Board has decided to grant approval for continuance of twenty-two seats of MS (General Surgery). Further, the annual intake capacity in the course of MS (General Surgery) will be reduced from the existing twenty-four seats to twenty-two seats for the Academic Year 2024-2025.** This reduction of seats shall remain valid for the Academic Year 2024-2025. However, subsequent restoration of seats will be based on the assessment of the medical college/institution as per the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023 (MSMER-2023). Hence, the break-up of **MS (General Surgery)** seats in the medical college will be as indicated below:

However, the students admitted by the medical college till the Academic Year 2023-2024 will not be affected by this reduction of seats and their post-graduate degrees will be considered recognised for the purpose of registration of the degree awarded by the University.

7. WHEREAS, the medical college is free to prefer an appeal before the National Medical Commission under Section 35(5) of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019 and Section 9 of Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023, within sixty days from the date of issuance of this letter in accordance with NMC letter No.C.16013/36/2022/NMC/Coord dated 28.12.2022 and 28.08.2023, if they so desire, at the email id nmc_appeal@nmc.org.in.
