Although culture is not synonymous with language, ethnicity, nationality, or socioeconomic status, groups with similar backgrounds with respect to these characteristics often share cultural norms and beliefs. Families' cultural traditions have a direct impact on the health of their children. Cultural norms influence how children and families see health, as well as how children's social development, attitudes toward health issues they encounter, and how they perceive disease and respond to treatment. Different cultures and religious practices. Nurses should be careful with the dimension of reflections of child and family's cultural practices and beliefs on health.

Paediatric ethics is a branch of bioethics that studies the moral ramifications of decisions made in children's healthcare. In general, the autonomy-driven underpinning of adult ethics is replaced by the benevolent paternalism (or parentalism) of paediatrics. Nurses are advocates for the patients and must find a balance while delivering patient care. There are four main principles of ethics: autonomy, beneficence, justice, and non- maleficence. Each patient has the right to make their own decisions based on their own beliefs and values. Nurses must have to be oriented with current scenario of cultural and ethical issues of pediatric nursing.
