OVERVIEW OF INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP

Mental, neurological and substance use disorders account for more than 10% of the global disease burden. Commonly, in low- and middle- income countries, 85% of people with mental disorders receive no treatment at all for their disorder. WHO Special Initiative for Mental Health was launched in 2019, although work began following a cross-country meeting held in Geneva in January 2020. Each country has already undertaken an initial assessment to get a broad picture of the mental health needs, available services, opportunities and main challenges for scale up. The strategies and strategies implementation plans developed in each country are dependent on results of the initial assessments and country priorities. However, they all include aspects of developing or improving mental health policy, and scaling up quality services in community-based and general health settings.

1. Special Initiative for Mental Health Situational Assessment and it's indicators
2. Creation of Community based services, integration into primary health care and strengthening of secondary level mental health services
