- Presentation should be prepared in MS power point and heading font size is 36 and regular text is 24.
- Number of slide 8 to 12 excluding first and last slide.
- ► Time of presentation 10 minutes (8 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes for discussion)
- Accepted paper will be informed through the email on or before 15th February 2024.
- ► All participants should email their respective abstract before the mentioned deadline 15th February 2024 in this email id conferencemhnsrmmcon@gmail.com
