1. I have read and fully understood the Code of Professional Conduct, the Rules for Students, the Penalties, and the provisions of the "UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009," as well as the Anti-Ragging Acts of the State and Central Government. I am also aware that as per the policy framed by the Executive Council of the University any act on part of the student of preventing the College/University authorities from taking any action against the students on the basis of the applicable rules or threatening them, in any manner, including causing harm to oneself and thereafter implicating the concerned authorities by making complaints to the authorities including police department, etc, shall also be considered to be a Misconduct & I shall be liable to all consequential punishment, actions by the competent authorities of the College/University.

- 2. I am aware that **petrol and diesel vehicles** are **strictly prohibited for undergraduate students**. However, I understand that **electric two-wheelers** are **allowed** for use by undergraduate students, and I agree to adhere to this policy.

  - o Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
  - Withholding results.
  - Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national, or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
  - o Fine which may extend up to five thousand rupees.
  - Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
  - Cancellation of admission.
  - Rustication from the institution for a period ranging from one to four semesters.
  - Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a period of five years from the date of the expulsion order.
  - Any other punishment as prescribed under Anti-Ragging Acts or the Anti-Ragging Rules and Regulations of the University Grants Commission, other applicable provisions of law, issued from time to time, read with/independently of the Anti-Ragging Affidavit submitted by myself and my parent/guardian.
- 5. #### 1) General Rules and Regulations:

- 1) The student hereby agrees to strictly adhere to all rules and regulations, policy decisions, etc., of Datta Meghe Institute of Higher Education and Research (Deemed to be University) Sawangi (Meghe)Wardha (hereinafter referred to as DMIHER (DU)/University) and its affiliated hostels under DMIHER(DU)as detailed below and as may be amended from time to time.
- 2) Admission to the hostel will be granted only to students with confirmed admission to the respective constituent colleges at DMIHER (DU).
- 3) On being admitted in the Hostel, it is mandatory for all students seeking admission in the Constituent College of DMIHER (DU) to stay in the hostel unless specifically exempted by the Competent Authority.
- 4) The Institute reserves the right to change the allocation of hostel rooms at any time at its sole discretion, without prior notice.

The Institute will not be held liable for accidents or injuries occurring in the hostel or institution unless they are directly caused by institutional negligence (e.g., faulty infrastructure or equipment). This limitation on liability applies to all incidents, except where liability is explicitly accepted by the institution in writing.

- 5) Rooms will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis, and no change of room is allowed after allotment without prior permission from the Hostel Management Authority. The Hostel Management Authority reserves the right to change room allocations as and when required.
- 6) Students are responsible for keeping their rooms and common areas clean and tidy. Any damage to hostel property will be will be assessed, and the cost of repairs or replacements will be recovered from responsible student(s). Hostel Furniture and fittings provided must remain in their designated places and cannot be moved or altered without permission.
- 7) In the event of a medical emergency, the institution will provide or seek medical assistance but will not be held liable for the outcomes unless caused by proven institutional negligence. Parents/Guardians agree to be informed immediately and will be responsible for making medical decisions if the student is incapacitated.

#### 2) Married Students:

- 1) If only one spouse is a student at DMIHER (DU), accommodation will be provided only to the student in the appropriate boys' or girls' hostel, as applicable.
- 2) If both spouses are students at DMIHER (DU), they will be allotted accommodation in the designated couple hostels or apartments. This arrangement ensures the privacy and convenience of the couple while upholding the integrity and discipline of the hostel environment.

- 3) Married students who are allotted couple hostels or apartments will not be permitted to stay in individual boys' or girls' hostels. This rule ensures that the designated spaces for couples are used appropriately and that individual hostels maintain their intended single-student occupancy.
- 4) The couple hostels/apartments will be equipped with facilities suitable for married couples, including private living spaces that provide an appropriate environment for both study and personal life. On seeking admission in the hostel, it shall be deemed that the concerned students have satisfied themselves about the environment and facilities provided and shall raise no dispute relating thereto any time in future.

## 3) Prohibitions:

- 1) The possession, use, or distribution of cigarettes, e-cigarettes, vape devices, hookah, pan masala, tobacco, gutkha, alcohol, or any other contraband substances within the Hostel and University premises is strictly prohibited. Violations of this rule will result in severe disciplinary actions, including fines, suspension, or expulsion, in accordance with DMIHER (DU) policies. Violations will result in severe disciplinary actions including fines, suspension, or expulsion.
- 2) Any damage to hostel property, whether intentional or due to negligence, is strictly prohibited. will result in penalties. These penalties may include full recovery of repair costs, fines, and possible suspension from the hostel.
- 4) Any form of ragging, harassment, or bullying, whether physical or mental, is strictly prohibited. Violators will face immediate expulsion from the hostel and disciplinary action as per university rules & regulations.
- 5) No day-scholar, ex-student, or unauthorized individual is permitted to enter in hostel premises without prior permission from the appropriate authority. Any violation of this rule will result in disciplinary action in accordance with hostel and university rules & regulations.

Further, Students who allow unauthorized individuals into the hostel are responsible for their actions. The institution will not be liable for any incidents involving these individuals unless the institution has directly granted access. Any issues caused by unauthorized individuals will be considered the student's liability.

6) Threatening or pressurising any of the Hostel Management authorities in any manner, from enforcing any of the applicable rules, regulations, policy decisions of the Hostel Management made from time to time etc.

## 4) Hostel Standards and Discipline:

- 1) Students must adhere to hostel curfew times (as specified) and are required to be present for daily attendance checks, which will be conducted between 09:00 pm and 10:30 pm every day.
- 2) Silence must be maintained between 9:00 pm and 6:00 am. Activities that disturb other students, such as loud music, parties, or shouting, are strictly prohibited. If found immediate action will be initiated against the violators.
- 3) Cooking in hostel rooms is strictly prohibited. The use of unauthorized electrical appliances such as heaters, hotplates, or induction stoves is forbidden. Violators will face penalties, including fines. (due to prevailing fire safety norms)
- 4) Students are solely responsible for the safety of their personal belongings. The Hostel Management Authority will not be held liable or responsible for any loss, theft or damage to personal belongings/property under any circumstances.
- 5) Students who return late to the hostel without prior permission may face disciplinary actions including warnings for the first three occurrences, written warnings for subsequent occurrences, and possible suspension for repeated violations.
- 6) Visitors are allowed only during the designated visiting hours and must register at the reception. No guests are allowed to stay overnight in the hostel without written permission from the Warden.

- 7) Students wishing to stay overnight outside the hostel must obtain prior written permission from the Warden. Applications for overnight stays should be submitted at least 24 hours in advance and must include details of the stay, including the name, address, and contact information of the person with whom the student will be staying.
- 8) Unauthorized absences will lead to disciplinary action. Parents or guardians will be notified in event of repeated violations.
- 9) The hostel will implement emergency protocols for fires, natural disasters, and other crises. Students are required to follow these protocols. Parents/guardians acknowledge that while the institution will take reasonable safety precautions, it cannot be held liable for all possible emergency situations.

#### 5) Complaint Redressal Mechanism:

- 1) Any grievances, complaints, or issues pertaining to the hostel must be reported immediately and directly to the concerned hostel warden. Students are required to follow proper channels and should not approach directly to higher authorities without first notifying the warden.
- 2) The warden is responsible for addressing complaints and resolving issues within a reasonable timeframe. If the complaint is not resolved satisfactorily, it may be escalated to the Hostel Management Authority, for necessary action.
- 3) A formal grievance procedure is in place and students are encouraged to follow it for resolving any disputes. For unresolved disputes, the institution may offer binding arbitration to avoid legal escalation.

# 6) Responsibilities of Parents/Guardians:

- 1) The parent/guardian acknowledges and accepts all rules and regulations outlined in this document and understands the potential consequences of any violations committed by their ward.
- 2) The parent/guardian agrees to be held accountable for their ward's misconduct. In the event of a violation, they accept any disciplinary actions taken by the University/Hostel Management Authority, including any applicable legal consequences.
- 3) Parents/Guardians shall furnish a personal security bond indemnifying DMIHER (DU) against any loss or damage resulting from actions of their ward.

This indemnity includes any claims, injuries, accidents, or other unforeseen circumstances that occur within the hostel or institution's premises unless caused by proven negligence of the institution. Additionally, students and parents acknowledge and accept the inherent risks associated with hostel living and that they accept these risks upon signing this document.
